

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From the desk of **Ed Capezzuti** <u>Happy New Year and a Look Ahead to 2024</u>

First, I wish you all a very happy, healthy and safe new year!

As we start 2024, it saddens me to say that the scammers are still around. Several people I know, including myself, have received calls from a recording asking if you have Part A and Part B of Medicare. We even received a call here at the Center, which tells me they are just fishing. Actually, I have received this call three times. One time I said "no" on the Part B premium and they hung up. Another time I asked, "how did you get my phone number?" and they hung up. I do not even remember how the third call went. What they are trying to do is get personal information or get you to change plans, as that is how they make money. Please remember, we are now in the time, until March 31st, when you can change from one plan to another, if you are not happy with what you have now. If you are thinking of changing, please let me know and I can put you in touch with a reputable insurance representative.

As of this writing, Humana is still in negotiations with Albany Medical Center, but it could end up that the AMC Health Care System will no longer accept Humana Medicare Advantage Plans. As of now, if you have Humana and go to AMC or other hospitals in the AMC system for services, the AMC system will accept Humana plans until June 1st, but there have been other dates flying around. IMPORTANT: Albany Medical Health System includes Glens Falls Hospital, Saratoga Hospital and Columbia Memorial as well as AMC. If you still have a WellCare plan, now is the time to change as the hospitals listed above are no longer in their network.

As I look back on 2023 and still wonder where the time goes, it was a great year here at the Center with many fun activities and we ended the year with a fantastic party with Chris O'Neil. The Center has many fun activities planned for 2024, as well. Cooking With Ed Friday, February 2nd at 1:00pm Italian Sausage and Zucchini Soup Prep/Total Time: 30 mins Serves: 6

Ingredients:

- 1 can (14-1/2 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh basil or 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh parsley or 1 teaspoon dried parsley flakes
- 1 medium zucchini, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 1 medium onion, chopped 3 cups beef broth

1/2 pound bulk Italian sausage 1 medium green pepper, chopped 1/2 cup uncooked orzo pasta

Directions:

1. In a large saucepan, cook sausage, onion and pepper over medium heat until sausage is no longer pink and vegetables are tender, 4-6 minutes, breaking sausage into crumbles: drain.

2. Add broth, tomatoes, basil and parsley; bring to a boil. Stir in zucchini and orzo; return to a boil. Cook, covered, until zucchini and orzo are tender, 10-12 minutes.

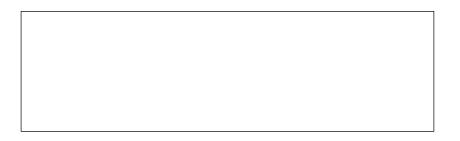




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
