End of the Year Information

This is the last article for 2020 and I wasn't really sure how to end this very unusual year but here it goes! On the good news front, the increase in the Part B premium is less than

originally thought. It will go from \$144.60 this year to \$148.50 next year and as I mentioned last month, Social Security announced an increase of 1.3% in your monthly benefit. Remember, if your Social Security increase is less than the Part B increase, your monthly check will not be less in 2021 due to Social Security rules. Also on the good news front, our friends from CDPHP have donated 6 laptops to our Center. We will be happy to loan them out to our members for their use, as well as keeping a couple here for use by our members at the Center. A big thank you to CDPHP for their generosity.

Please remember, the open enrollment period will end on December 7th. Your insurance will take effect on January 1st. If you change plans during open enrollment and find out in early 2021 (January to the end of March) that you are unhappy with your new plan, you can change plans during that period of time. Additionally, if you have EPIC (Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage) you can change plans one time during the year.

In early January, we were looking forward to another exciting year with many events planned at the Center, which came to an abrupt stop in March and has continued on as of this writing. We have all had to adjust our lives and not necessarily in a good way. Who thought that wearing a mask would be an important part of our wardrobe? 


