The new rating system is designed to enhance your experience and ensure you pick the excursions that best suit your interests!

Level 1 Very Easy. A leisurely pace involving minimal physical activity, such as climbing stairs and walking for a short amount of time.

Level 2 Easy. Normal, generally flat walking for longer distances, standing, and other similar activities for average amounts of time.

Level 3 Moderate. Walking or physical activities for half or most of the day. Periods of standing, stairs, or uneven walking surfaces are expected.

Level 4 Strenuous. All or most of the day. Long periods of walking, uneven terrain, and standing. No walkers or canes allowed.

Cooking With Ed Thursday, October 9th 1 pm Stuffed Pepper Soup

1 package (8.8 ounces) ready-to-serve long grain and wild rice I pound ground beef
2 cups chopped green peppers
1 cup chopped onion
1 jar (26 ounces) chunky tomato pasta sauce
1 can (14-1/2 ounces) Italian diced tomatoes, undrained
1 can (14 ounces) beef broth

Directions:

I. Prepare rice according to package directions. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan, cook the beef, green peppers and onion until meat is no longer pink, crumbling beef; drain. Stir in the pasta sauce, tomatoes, broth and prepared rice; heat through.

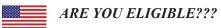
